Programme in Detail

Discover Hanoi City Walks – English walk

Tràng Tiền street and surrounding area

Sunday 7 May 2017

Tràng Tiền and surrounding roads such as Hàng Bài, Bà Triệu, Hàng Khay etc. are no doubt familiar to most of us. As we stroll these streets we will touch on the area's development from the early days of Hanoi through the French period to the present time, hear some of its eclectic stories and history, notes on theatre and the cinema and the former 'lives' of some familiar and not so familiar buildings. Hopefully you will discover things you didn't know about these well-known streets and buildings. Our simple but detailed route will take us from



the steps of the Opera House, down Tràng Tiền towards Hoàn Kiếm lake, into Hàng Bài, towards Hàm Long and back up to Bà Triệu and Hàng Khay with a few interesting hidden diversions on the way. Estimated time the walk will end - approximately 12noon. (please refer to updated joining notes which will be sent after registration)

Saturday 13 May 2017

Lai Xá (photography) village is associated with many former notable and prominent people (who sadly have died). The village, in Kim Chung Commune 15km west of Hanoi, is the **birthplace of photography in Vietnam** - it is recognised as the photography village and is the hometown of many special talented photographers and scholars.

- 1. *Khánh Ký* eminent photographer who taught photography to Ho Chi Minh. Khánh Ký is regarded as the father of photography in Vietnam. He was born in the village in 1874
- 2. *Prof. Dr. Nguyễn Văn Huyên* (1908-1975) historian, ethnologist and culture researcher. And Minister of Education for 29 years
- 3. Vũ Đinh Hồng Ho Chi Minh's photographer (1960-69)
- 4. Nguyễn Quang Quyền former president of the Ho Chi Minh University of Medicine
- 5. Nguyển Quang Thái a very popular mathematician
- 6. Nguyển Văn Chánh photographer

Morning part 1

We are the guests of **Mr Nguyễn Văn Huy** (and his wife) - the founding Director of the Museum of Ethnology - at the **Nguyễn Văn Huyên** museum. On dsplay at this museum are nearly 400 objects and documents of the 20th century on the life and career of Minister of Education Nguyễn Văn Huyên (the father of Nguyễn Văn Huy). This is a wonderful, amazingly created, high quality and unique family museum. Spread over 4 compact floors it tells the story of the Minister's life and that of his family, gives a superb insight into



society and its changes, the politics and history of the nation – through the eyes of this one (both special but ordinary) family. Mr Huy will be our guide and its also a great chance to talk more with this very interesting person who is still active in Vietnamese education and museums.

After lunch (either bring packed lunch to eat in the museum courtyard or take time to wander the village eat in a local food stall).

Afternoon part 2

2 days after our visit, the village plans to officially open a new museum dedicated to photography. We are keeping our fingers crossed that they may open the museum especially for our group which will be great honour for us.

We will also visit the home of one of the village's elderly photographers. He delights in telling stories of his life and

the art of photography which give great insight into the Vietnam's society and history at the time.

Our afternoon session will be led by Mr Nam who is a volunteer guide at the Nguyễn Văn Huyên museum.

Most of the people we meet do not speak English or limited English so we will have translation.

Traditional Medicine - workshop

Saturday 20 May 2017: afternoon event + dinner

This is a 2 part event – traditional Vietnamese medicine work shop followed by a traditional Thai ethnic minority dinner

Thanks to one of our members, FVH has been extremely fortunate to meet an amazing traditional medicine practitioner. Ms Phuong is of the Thai ethnic minority from Mộc Châu. She has been in Hanoi for a long time. Her family are leading (purely) Vietnamese traditional medicine experts in her home region; in Vietnam her expertises is highly sought after. She is famed for a number of her own special recipes supplied to a leading Vietnamese traditional pharmaceutical/medicine company. She has also been asked to set up a new traditional medicine hospital in Saigon. She has many more accolades far too many to mention here.

She was delighted when we asked if she could run a traditional medicine workshop for a small group of FVH members. It will take place in her homestay. She has a small house in Trần Quốc Toản near Thiền Quang Lake, and she converted the interior in the style of a Thai minority house, including cooking by open fire inside.



The current schedule is likely to be:

2.30pm start. Learn about Vietnamese traditional medicine & the Thai community (which greatly contributes to the preservation of this traditional medicine skill) followed by a traditional medicine workshop session – a chance to make some "recipes" under her guidance

Day Excursion and activities

A fun day at **Ba Vì green tea village** and **Ba Vì homestead** in Nghe Hamlet, Vân Hòa Commune, Ba Vì district. We will take part in various agricultural activities such as learning how to make tea, planting rice, catching fish etc. *Activities include:*

Learning about this hillside tea community made up of 9 villages. Take part in picking tea and how the tea is dried by traditional machine. Hear about the traditional Vietnamese tea culture and how to make a good pot of tea.





Lunch in the village (bring a picnic lunch)

After lunch we head to Ba Vì Homestead and take part in some interesting and traditional agricultural activities. These include rice planting, catching fish with traditional equipment and chicken catching. We also learn how to make "cuon" rice pancake and will visit the 1,000-year old tree and watch/take part in traditional Muong dancing.

This is a traditional agricultural area, beautiful setting with rice fields and streams from Ba Vì mountain.

We aim to depart the area around 4pm/4.30pm but we ask for flexibility in case some activities take a bit longer
